

ORDINANCE NO. O-027-2015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH COUNCIL CHANGING THE POLLING LOCATIONS, RENAMING AND RENUMBERING PRECINCTS AS AUTHORIZED AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE LOUISIANA ELECTION CODE, LA R.S. 18:1, ET SEQ.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: LEGISLATIVE INTENT. The Louisiana Election Code, La R.S. 18:1, *et seq.*, and in particular, La R.S. 18:532-537, provide that Parish governing authorities may change polling locations and the boundaries and designations of election precincts. In this instance, such changes are necessary due to (1) upcoming construction at the SLCC Ardoin Building, (2) previous temporary movement of the polling locations of Precincts 1, 3, and 6 from Carencro Middle School Gym to Live Oak School, (3) renumbering certain precincts for administrative clarity and convenience, and (4) renaming certain precincts to clarify multiple precincts and locations within a building. These changes require no changes in election districts and have no fiscal impact on the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government. It is for these stated reasons that this ordinance is enacted.

SECTION 2: CHANGE IN VOTING LOCATIONS. In accordance with the Louisiana Election Code, La R.S. 18:1 *et seq.*, including but not limited to La. R.S. 18:532-537, certain Lafayette Parish polling places are hereby changed to the locations shown on the list attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof by reference.

SECTION 3: RENAMING OF PRECINCTS. The Precinct names for the polling locations at Allen Comeaux Recreation Center are hereby changed as shown in the attached Exhibit “A,” and in accordance with La. R.S. 18:532.1.

SECTION 4: RENUMBERING OF PRECINCTS. The Precinct numbers for the polling locations at Carencro High School are hereby changed as shown in the attached Exhibit “A,” and in accordance with La. R.S. 18:532.1.

SECTION 5: OTHER ACTION. Once this ordinance has been adopted, the Legal Department of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government will submit the ordinance to the Louisiana Secretary of State and the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters. Furthermore, the Legal Department of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government will submit a copy of the ordinance to the Information and Technology Department, GIS Division, with the request to have the department adjust all voting precinct maps to reflect the changes made by this ordinance.

SECTION 6: REPEAL. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective upon

signature of the Lafayette City-Parish President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette City-Parish President without signature or veto, upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
