ORDINANCE NO. O-060-2008

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH COUNCIL
ACCEPTING THE FINDINGS OF THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS FOR LAFAYETTE
PARISH AS TO NEW VOTING PRECINCT BOUNDARIES TO DIVIDE PRECINCT 101
AND PRECINCT 110

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for the State of Louisiana has notified the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government that the 2007 population canvass has been completed and that Lafayette Parish was identified as having certain precincts containing more than two thousand two hundred (2,200) active registered voters, which is the maximum amount of active registered voters permitted in a voting precinct under Louisiana law; and

WHEREAS, it was required that the governing authority of Lafayette Parish, Louisiana design and implement a plan to change the voting precincts such that none of the voting precincts would have more than two thousand two hundred (2,200) active registered voters; and

WHEREAS, the Registrar of Voters for Lafayette Parish has prepared a plan ("the <u>Plan</u>") as requested by the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government, to satisfy the requirements of Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, the Plan requires the division of Precinct 101 into two (2) precincts to be known as Precinct 101 and Precinct 110, which precincts shall have the following geographic descriptions, to-wit:

NEW BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION FOR PRECINCT 101:

Beginning at the intersection of LA Hwy 89 (Youngsville Hwy.) and Heart D Farm Road, East on Heart D Farm Road to the intersection of N. Larriviere Rd., South on N. Larriviere Road to the intersection of W. Fairfield Road, East on W. Fairfield Road continuing onto E. Fairfield to the intersection of Saint Etienne Road, North on St. Etienne Road to the intersection of Corne Road, East on Corne Road to the intersection of US Hwy 90 East, South on US Hwy 90 East to the Parish Line and the intersection of Bayou Tortue, Then a north westerly direction following Bayou Tortue to the intersection on LA Hwy 182 (Youngsville Hwy), North on LA Hwy 182 (Youngsville Hwy) to the intersection of Heart D Farm Road at the point of beginning.

NEW BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION FOR PRECINCT 110:

Beginning at the intersection of Heart D Farm Road, intersecting with N. Larriviere Road, South on N. Larriviere Road to the intersection of W. Fairfield Road, east on W. Fairfield continuing onto E. Fairfield Road to the intersection of Saint Etienne Road, North on Saint Etienne Road to the intersection of Corne Road. West on Corne Road to the intersection of US Hwy 90 East, North on US Hwy 90 East to the intersection of LA Hwy 182, then northwest to the intersection of Saint Etienne Road, West south west on Saint Etienne to the intersection of Moulin Road, West on Moulin Road to the intersection of S. Morgan Ave., South on S. Morgan Ave., to the intersection of

Heart D Farm Road, West on Heart D Farm Road to its intersection of N. Larriviere Road at the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, the existing boundaries of Precinct 101 is shown on the plat attached hereto, and made a part hereof, as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the newly constituted Precinct 101 and Precinct 110 are shown on the plat attached hereto, and made a part hereof, as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, the voting place for the new Precincts 101 and Precinct 110 has been established at Broussard Middle School in Broussard, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government to approve such Plan; and

WHEREAS, Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government has reviewed the Plan prepared by the Registrar of Voters and is in agreement therewith; and accordingly,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: All of the aforementioned "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: The Lafayette City-Parish President, on behalf of Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government, is hereby directed to sign any documents, maps or other papers reasonably necessary to accept or implement the Plan as prepared by the Registrar of Voters and as described herein.

SECTION 3: The Plan and a copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded to the United States Department of Justice and to any necessary State of Louisiana agencies or entities for their concurrence and/or approval.

SECTION 4: Subject to approval by the United States Department of Justice and any other governmental agency or entity whose approval is required by law, the Plan adopted herein as to the voting precincts shall become effective on, or as soon thereafter as authorized by the laws of the State of Louisiana.

SECTION 5: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette City-Parish President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette City-Parish

- (b) Agenda Item Submittal Form.




