

ORDINANCE NO. O-095-2011

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH COUNCIL
SPLITTING CERTAIN PRECINCTS TO ESTABLISH THE BOUNDARIES OF
CERTAIN CITY-PARISH COUNCIL DISTRICTS DELINEATED IN THE PLAN OF
REDISTRICTING FOR THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH COUNCIL FOLLOWING
THE 2010 FEDERAL CENSUS BY THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF THE CENSUS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City-Parish Council has reviewed six (6) proposed Plans of Redistricting, and variations thereof, following the 2010 Federal Census by the United States Bureau of the Census and has determined that it will adopt the plan identified as "LCG-LPSB Draft Plan 5b-1 Districts" and submit such Plan of Redistricting to the United States Department of Justice for preclearance under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C.A. § 1973, *et seq.*, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the "LCG-LPSB Draft Plan 5b-1 Districts" requires that a certain Precinct be split to establish the boundaries of certain City-Parish Council Districts delineated in such plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: The aforescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: Precinct 64 within Lafayette Parish is hereby divided into split Precincts as noted herein in order to establish the boundaries of certain City-Parish Council Districts delineated in the Plan of Redistricting identified as "LCG-LPSB Draft Plan 5b-1 Districts" to be adopted by the Lafayette City-Parish Council.

SECTION 3: The Precinct within Lafayette Parish split herein is divided by visible features and/or municipal boundaries, which are census tabulation boundaries, as required by law, and the division of the Precincts shall be, as follows:

<u>PREVIOUS PRECINCT</u>	divided into	<u>NEW SPLIT PRECINCTS</u>

SECTION 4: The visible boundaries of the new precincts are hereby described, as follows:

PRECINCT 64A: Beginning at the intersection of N. University Avenue (Louisiana Hwy. 182) and Gloria Switch Road (Louisiana Hwy. 98), then east and south on Gloria Switch Road (Louisiana Hwy. 98) to Lumina Drive, then west on Lumina Drive to Louis Arceneaux Road, then south on Louis Arceneaux Road to W. Butcher Switch Road, then west on W. Butcher Switch Road to N. University Avenue, then north on N. University Avenue (Louisiana Hwy. 182) to Gloria Switch (Louisiana Hwy. 98) and the point of beginning.

PRECINCT 64B: Beginning at the intersection of N. University Avenue (Louisiana Hwy. 182) and W. Butcher Switch Road, then east on W. Butcher Road to Louis Arceneaux Road, then north on Louis Arceneaux Road to Lumina Drive, then east on Lumina Drive to Gloria Switch Road (Louisiana Hwy. 98), then east on Gloria Switch Road (Louisiana Hwy. 98) to Interstate 49, then south on Interstate 49 to Interstate 10, then west on Interstate 10 to the Southern Pacific Railroad (or assigns), north on the Southern Pacific Railroad (or assigns) to the Trans Louisiana Gas Company, Inc., natural gas pipeline, then west on Trans Louisiana Gas Company, Inc., natural gas pipeline to N. University Avenue (Louisiana Hwy. 182), the north on N. University Avenue (Louisiana Hwy. 182) to W. Butcher Switch Road and the point of beginning.

SECTION 5: All Ordinances and/or Resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance is effective upon signature of the Lafayette City-Parish President, or the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette City-Parish President without signature, whichever occurs first, but subject to the Lafayette City-Parish Council adopting Ordinance No. O-096-2011 effectuating the Plan of Redistricting identified as "LCG-LPSB Draft Plan 5b-1 Districts" and preclearance of such plan and Precinct split adopted hereby by the United States Department of Justice under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C.A. § 1973, *et seq.*, as amended, and other applicable Louisiana law.
